

MINISTRY ALIGNMENTS & SATELLITE MINISTRIES

Midwest Regional Apostolic Center

Midwest Regional Apostolic Center encourages the development of a prophetic community, where everyone hears from the Lord and honors the Lord by walking with Him in faith, love, and obedience. Thus, we become the Lord's community, aligned in His body as ONE in the Spirit, living in harmony with one another.

ALL believers are called to minister. God gives us His spiritual gifts and His supernatural wisdom, power and authority to equip us for the work of the ministry. There is a Divine calling, purpose, and destiny, written in His book, for every believer. The Seven Mountain mandate provides for everyone a place and an opportunity to serve the Lord with their gifts, talents, and skills. (The Seven Mountains are: family, religion, government, education, business, media, and arts and entertainment.) There is much freedom and joy in Christ when we find our purpose and destiny in Him and are rightly aligned and positioned by the Spirit of the Lord for His work and glory.

God is aligning His army of workers and their ministries. We will define a Satellite Ministry here, for a better understanding of how God is leading Midwest Regional Apostolic Center. Through our relationships and spiritual connections, we see Jesus building His Church into a Community of like-minded believers.

1. A Satellite Ministry may be a new young ministry, or an older developed ministry or transitioning church that seeks to be in alignment with an apostolic center, led by an apostolic and prophetic spiritual father and mother. It is this relational bond and spiritual connection that God has brought about between the two of them, that forms the spiritual alignment. A satellite ministry may be near or distant in regard to its physical location to the apostolic center.

2. A Satellite Ministry agrees to align with an apostolic center for the benefits of training and equipping which the alignment provides. The apostolic ministry does not control or rule over the satellite ministry. Rather, the apostolic nurtures, encourages, and faithfully prays for the satellite ministry or church. It offers

council when sought-out by the satellite ministry. This loving, nurturing relationship between the two, strengthens each one's faith and promotes the unity of the Spirit, while God is at work accomplishing the spiritual growth and maturity of His body, which is His community.

3. All Ministries are under the covering and authority of the Lord Jesus Christ. Every ministry birthed by the Spirit belongs to Jesus and must give an account to Him regarding its faith and obedience. Every ministry receives a revelation or vision from God, as to its purpose, function, and calling. Every ministry is subject to the Holy Spirit's leading, counsel, and guidance. No ministry is to be a work of the flesh, but is the work of the Holy Spirit. Alignment with an apostolic center offers the Satellite Ministry additional wisdom and guidance through its counsel, and offers additional insight and discernment against the enemy's lies, deception, snares, and attacks.

4. A Satellite Ministry enjoys affirmation and security in its relationship with the apostolic center, while the two journey together in unity, faith, and love. This encourages the community of Christ to grow stronger in faith and confidence, especially at times of spiritual warfare engagements. Fixing our eyes on Jesus, together we set our goal to see His Kingdom advance and reign on earth over the kingdom of darkness.
